



# One minute Feng Shui - part 8

24th Minute - Check if kitchen and bathroom facing each other?

Kitchen is 'fire' and while bathroom is 'water' in accordance to 5 elements theory, when fire meets with water resulted in destructive scenario of constant family member's argument and disagreements.

Take a minute to check if your home falls in such situation. If yes, do not worry, there is always a solution from Feng Shui perspective, just simply place a green carpet or water plants on either side of the door to produce a "bridging" effect for such pitfall. You will argue less with spouse or family members after you take such action.

25th Minute - 'Bright Hall' with uneven or slope down toward outer road?

Bright hall is the front of a house or business premises. Example of 'Bright Hall' is the car parking area as well as front pavements. The area ideally should be slope in to your house or business premises front door rather than other wise. It is best for 'Bright Hall' to receive kind energies rather than retreat such energies. Take a minute to figure out your setting and if you find your 'bright hall' is sloping out, you had better move out! If you cannot move, ideally you should place a water fountain or a cup of water inside your house next or near your front door.

26th Minute - Check your garage, arrangement of tools and clutter?

Garage is supposed to store cars and its accessories and nothing more than that.

Clutter is stagnant energy and prevent the inflow of new and kind energies while permeate old and unkind energies. Clear clutter for new kind energies. Take a minute to have a checklist of what you have in your garage and donate out unnecessary items and keep them all clean.

27th Minute - Check your garden, arrangement of plants or lawn?

Nicely mowed lawn and well-arranged trees, flowers and plants is essentially good Feng Shui and good energies. Take a minute to review your garden and later in the chapter, we will deal specifically on Feng Shui garden.

28th Minute - Check, if any, the number and types of plants in your house?

The type of plants and number of plants is critical for Feng Shui arrangement and good energies. Check the number of plants inside your house and see the significant and what they represent.

Take one minute to calculate the number of plants in your house. 1 or 11 signify to harness relationship and promote camaraderie. 2 or 12 signify sickness and you should avoid it. 3 or 13 are bad for relationships and promote constant argument. 4 or 14 are ideal for academic excellence especially for children. 5 or 15 are bad for health and should avoid this number. 6 or 16 are meant for side those who work in commission basis that will boost extra incomes. 7 or 17 are bad, as this will promote traffic accidents. 8 or 18 are superb for improving financial status, while 9 or 19 are excellent in your plan to conceive!
